

EOG GAME: PICK A CARD - ANY CARD

- **Materials:** Reading Selection (copy for each student), 1 answer sheet per group, individual questions cut up and put on cards
- Put students into teams of 4. Have students count off. (Note: *students can also do this in pairs or threes*)
- Teacher distributes question cards and answer sheet to each group.
- Students (*either individually, as a group chorally, or in pairs*) read a given EOG released selection (*or other appropriate selection w/ questions*) within their group.
- Question cards are stacked in the middle of the group with answer sheet turned face down.
- Student #1 picks up the cards and fans them and turns to Student #2 and says, "Pick a card, any card."
- Student #2 picks a card and reads aloud the question on the card to Student #3.
- Student #3 answers the question (A,B,C, or D).
- Student #4 takes the answer sheet and checks the answer. If wrong answer was given, the correct answer is given. Answer sheet is then laid back face down as play moves on.
- Play continues with the #2 student beginning the second round of play.
- Play continues until all questions are answered.



NUMBERED HEADS RESPONSE

- Students within a team of 2-4 have an assigned number 1-4.
- Teacher poses a question and students put their heads together to discuss the answer.
- The teacher randomly calls out a number.
- Student from each team with that number writes the team's response on the team's response board (white board, chalk board, or holds up an answer card)



SHOWDOWN

- Students are in a team of 2-6.
- Each team selects a leader.
- Teacher poses a question to the class.
- Students each write down their answer on individual response boards (white boards, chalk board, cards, etc.)
- Leader says, "Showdown" and team members compare and discuss answers.
- Team collaborates on one answer.
- Teacher calls "Class Showdown" and each leader holds up their team's answer
